El gráfico en la parte posterior de este folleto incluye todos los programas invertidos en las contribuciones hechas a nuestra última campaña.

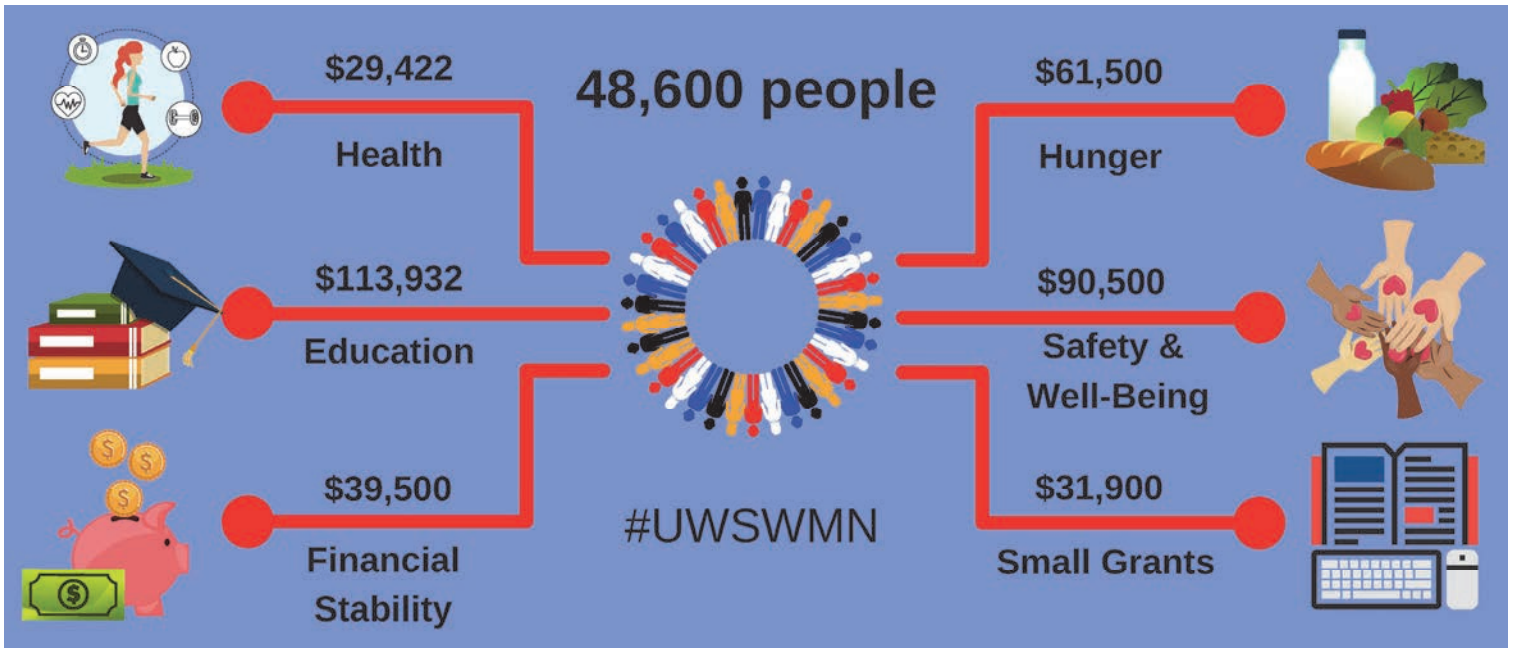
